



Bordetella is a canine respiratory illness somewhat similar to the flu. There are many strains of Bordetella. Dogs are particularly susceptible when under any kind of stress, like being away from family. Thus, the nickname "Kennel Cough". Vaccines offered by veterinarians cover most, but not all forms of Bordetella.
